THE PROGRAMME

Football, in one page.

15 days · 14 nights (10-day option available)

Up to 4 fixtures against Thai academy and school opposition

Tour lead: Matt Jarvis, former West Ham United and Wolves winger

A pre-season or off-season tour for UK college and academy squads, players aged 16 to 19: structured training blocks, fixtures against Thai opposition, and the cultural programme Beyond Adventure runs for UK colleges every year. Thailand's dry season, November to February, lines up with the UK academic year: reliable weather, grass pitches in daily use, and touring costs below European destinations. Hua Hin already hosts professional squads for pre-season at Arena Hua Hin: 4 FIFA-size pitches on Paspalum grass.

Every session is planned around the heat. Training runs 07:00 to 09:00 and 16:30 to 18:30. Fixtures kick off at 17:00 or later. Water and electrolyte drinks at every session, with scheduled breaks every 20 minutes.

Safeguarding, built in.

Standard student safeguarding applies throughout: agreed staff-to-player ratios, single-sex rooming by year group, supervised free time, and a named duty manager on 24/7 call. Every venue is personally site-inspected and the full risk assessment pack is formatted for college and local-authority approval.

Two companies, one programme.

International Student Experiences (ISE) is the UK side of the partnership: it works directly with your college to scope the tour, the age groups, the dates and the budget, and manages planning and administration end to end. **Beyond Adventure (Thailand) Co., Ltd.** is the Thailand side: a licensed Thai tour operator based in Kanchanaburi, operating every day on the ground from airport pickup to final farewell. Our guides, Tik, First and Jung, are with the squad every day.

WHAT THE SQUAD TAKES HOME

A better team, and more.

- Up to 4 fixtures against Thai academy and school opposition, refereed and photographed
- A structured training block at facilities used by professional squads for pre-season
- The Matt Jarvis masterclass and sessions, per the tour schedule agreed with ISE
- The cultural programme Beyond Adventure runs for UK colleges: the River Kwai, Erawan, Hellfire Pass, a homestay dinner
- Independent travel experience across 15 days and 3 locations, inside a safeguarding framework colleges can sign off

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Everything from the airport, back to the airport.

- 14 nights accommodation: twin or triple share for players, staff rooms on the same floor
- All meals, menus agreed with team staff, dietary lists itemised per player, unlimited bottled water, electrolyte drinks at every session
- All ground transport by private coach, plus a support vehicle for kit and first aid
- Pitch hire, matchday logistics, referees, and liaison with Thai opposition
- English-speaking licensed guides throughout, plus a duty manager on 24/7 call
- First-aid trained staff at every session and fixture, with an evacuation plan naming the nearest hospital at each venue
- Full risk assessment pack, formatted for college and local-authority approval

Not included: international flights, travel insurance (mandatory, we verify cover before departure), personal spending money, and the tour lead's fee, which sits with ISE.

THE PRACTICAL ANSWERS

What colleges and parents ask first.

Visa	Not required for UK passport holders staying under 30 days. The Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC) is completed before travel. We send instructions and check every entry.
Heat	Sessions run 07:00 to 09:00 and 16:30 to 18:30, never midday. Fixtures kick off at 17:00 or later. Hydration is scheduled, not optional.
Vaccinations	Hepatitis A and up-to-date Tetanus are required. Typhoid is a NaTHNaC recommendation. Students confirm with their GP.
Rooms & meals	Two or three players per room, single-sex by year group. Staff on the same floor. All meals included.
Insurance	Travel insurance must cover contact sport for 16 to 19s. We verify every policy before departure.
Safety	Every venue is personally site-inspected. Activity and fixture risk assessments are provided for college approval. First aid at every session.
Support	Our team is reachable 24/7 for the full 15 days. Heart answers +66 85 299 8329 at any hour.

NEXT STEPS

From this outline to a confirmed tour.

1. A scoping call: age group, squad size, dates and budget.
2. A full proposal and quotation within 48 hours of the call, for both the 15-day and 10-day variants.
3. Fixtures, venues and the tour lead's session schedule confirmed in writing before anything is promised to parents.
4. The full documentation pack: itinerary, risk assessments, parent information, and pre-departure briefing support.
