Thailand hosts the 52nd World Pétanque Championship, Khon Kaen 2026

Thailand is the strongest pétanque nation outside France. The national team topped the medal table at the 2023 World Championships in Benin with 3 golds, and has won 10 world golds since 2010. Roughly 40,000 licensed players roll on courts in public parks, army bases and villages in every province. Your club plays friendlies against Thai clubs on their own ground, and between the matches we run the Thailand we know: the river, the waterfalls, the food.

This is an adult tour. Twin and single hotel rooms, evenings left flexible, and an itinerary paced for players who want to play well and eat well. Fixtures are arranged to match the club's standard.

Two companies, one tour.

International Student Experiences (ISE) is the UK side of the partnership: it works directly with your club to scope the tour, the dates and the budget, and manages planning and administration end to end.

Beyond Adventure (Thailand) Co., Ltd. is the Thailand side: a licensed Thai tour operator based in Kanchanaburi, operating every day on the ground from airport pickup to final farewell. Our guides, Tik, First and Jung, are with the group every day.

DAYS 1 TO 2 · BANGKOK

Arrive, then the first roll on Thai ground.

1	Arrival: Bangkok Arrive Suvarnabhumi Airport. Our team meets the group at arrivals. Private transfer to the hotel. Evening welcome dinner on the Chao Phraya river.	Arrival; welcome
2	Grand Palace, then Fixture 1 Morning at the Grand Palace and Wat Pho. Afternoon: the first friendly with a Bangkok club at the Secret Garden court, Sukhumvit Soi 26. Evening free.	Fixture 1

DAYS 3 TO 6 · KANCHANABURI

The river, the history, and the second fixture.

DAY	PROGRAMME	FOCUS
3	West to the River Kwai Coach west, about 2.5 hours. The Bridge over the River Kwai, the Death Railway Museum and the Allied War Cemetery. Check in at a riverside resort.	History; arrival
4	Erawan National Park Walk the waterfall tiers, swim in the pools, picnic lunch. Evening: informal boules at the resort.	Recovery; play
5	Fixture 2: Kanchanaburi Morning friendly against a Kanchanaburi club, arranged with the local playing community. Afternoon: long-tail boat on the River Kwai or free time. Group dinner.	Fixture 2
6	Hellfire Pass and the Death Railway The memorial walk at Hellfire Pass, then the Death Railway train across the Tham Krasae viaduct. Evening free at the night market.	History; culture

DAYS 7 TO 9 · HUA HIN AND HOME

The seaside fixture, then back through Bangkok.

7	South to Hua Hin Coach south via Phetchaburi, about 4 hours. Afternoon at leisure. Evening at the Hua Hin night market.	Travel; leisure
8	Fixture 3: Hua Hin Morning friendly against a Hua Hin club: the town has an active playing scene, including resident expatriate players. Afternoon beach or golf option. Farewell dinner.	Fixture 3

9	Departure Coach to Suvarnabhumi Airport, about 3.5 hours, timed to the group's flight. We stay with the group until departures.	Departure

WHAT THE CLUB TAKES HOME

More than three matches.

- 3 friendlies against Thai clubs, in 3 different provinces, with boules-side hospitality and a translator at every match
- The story of playing in the country that topped the 2023 world championship medal table
- The River Kwai, Erawan Falls, Hellfire Pass and the Death Railway, guided by people who live there
- 8 nights in vetted hotels and riverside resorts, paced for adults
- A relationship with Thai clubs the tour can build on next year

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Everything from the airport, back to the airport.

- 8 nights accommodation: 3 to 4 star hotels and riverside resorts, twin share, singles on request
- Daily breakfast plus the group meals named in the itinerary. Other evenings free by design
- All ground transport by private air-conditioned coach, airport to airport
- Fixture logistics on the Thai side: venue booking, court fees, host club hospitality, a translator at each match
- An English-speaking licensed Thai guide with the group throughout
- 24/7 on-ground support: the Managing Director's personal WhatsApp is on every document

Not included: international flights, travel insurance (mandatory, we verify cover before travel), personal spending money, single room supplement.

THE PRACTICAL ANSWERS

What players ask first.

Visa	Not required for UK passport holders staying under 30 days. The Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC) is completed before travel. We send instructions and check every entry.
Season	November to February is dry season, 25 to 32 degrees, the best playing weather. April is not recommended: peak heat and Songkran closures.
Rooms	Twin share as standard. Singles available at a supplement, priced per group.
Playing level	Fixtures are friendlies, arranged to match the club's standard. A structured competitive match can be added on request.
Safety	Every venue is personally site-inspected. Risk assessment documentation is available on request, in the format ISE requires.
Support	Our team is reachable 24/7 for all 9 days. Heart answers +66 85 299 8329 at any hour.

NEXT STEPS

From this outline to a confirmed tour.

1. The club confirms interest and a working window of dates.
2. A scoping call: group size, playing level, room mix and budget.

3. A full quotation within 5 working days of the call, built for the group.
4. Fixtures and venues confirmed in writing with Thai clubs before anything is promised to players.
